SRO- 122 - In exercise of the powers conferred by section 10 of the Jammu and Kashmir registration of Contractors Act, 1956 (Act No. XVI of 1956), the Government hereby makes the following rules, namely:-

1. Short title, commencement and application :-

- (1) These rules may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Registration of Contractors Rules, 1991.
- (2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Government Gazette.
- (3) They shall apply to the following departments namely:-

- (a) Roads and Buildings Department;
- (b) Irrigation and Flood Control Department and Ravi Tawi Irrigation Complex Deptt.
- (c) Public Health Engineering Department;
- (d) Medicinal Department;
- (e) Stores Procurement Department;
- (f) Power Development Department;
- (g) Forests, Fisheries, Tourism and Industries Department;
- (h) Municipalities, Local Bodies and CU and NFSI Department;
- (i) Housing and Urban Development Department and Urban Environmental Engineering Department;
- (j) Estates Organization; and
- (k) any other Government Department required to execute civil construction works.

(2) Definitions:- In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:-

- (a) "Act" means the Jammu and Kashmir registration of Contractors Act, 1956;
- (b) "Contractor" means contractor registered by such under these rules;
- (c) "Form" means a form appended to these rules;
- (d) "Publ. Works Department" means all or any of the departments mentioned in sub rule (3) of rule 1.
- (e) "Registrar" means the registrar of Contractors mentioned under these rules;
- (f) All words and expressions used but not defined in these rules shall have the same meanings as assigned to them in the Jammu and Kashmir registration of Contractors Act, 1956.

3. Categories, Classification of Contractors and Area of Operation:- (1) In Public works Department enlistment of Contractors shall be done in the following two categories:-

- (a) Civil Works;
(b) Sanitary and Water Supply;

(2) Civil Works Contractors:- There shall be following classes of contractors in each Department with such Areas of operation and the limits upto which Contractor of a particular class shall be allotted works, as indicated against each:-

Class of Contractors.	Limits upto which works can be allotted.	Areas of operation.
Special Class	any amount above Rupees fifty lacs.	All the three regions of J&K State viz. Jammu Kashmir and Ladakh
Class 'A'	Above Rupees ten lacs upto Rupees fifty lacs.	All the three regions of J&K state viz. Jammu, Kashmir and Ladakh.
Class 'B'	Above Rupees five lacs upto Rupees Ten Lacs.	All the three regions of J&K State viz. Jammu Kashmir Ladakh.
Class 'C'	Above Rupees one Lacs upto Rupees five lacs.	Any one of the three regions, viz, Jammu Kashmir and Ladakh.
Class 'D'	Upto Rupees one Lacs.	any one of the Zones specified below.

Explanation:

- (1) The applicant seeking enlistment in class 'c' and class 'd' shall be required to choose the region / zone of his choice respectively at the time of submitting application for enlistment for area of operation;
- (2) In case a contractor wants to change his region/zone he shall have to surrender his enlistment certificate in the particular region/zone where he has been registered and shall have to seek fresh registration for the new region/zone where he intends to execute work.
- (3) For the purpose of enlistment or making choice for being enlisted for a particular Zone, the demarcation of areas is specified as under:
- Zone I. Districts of Leh and Kargil
Zone II. Districts of Baramulla and Kupwara
Zone III. Districts of Srinagar and Budgam.
Zone IV. District of Anantnag and Pulwama
Zone V. Districts of Udhampur and Doda,
Zone VI. Districts of Rajouri and Poonch.
Zone VII. Districts of Jammu and Kathua.

4. Eligibility - No person shall be eligible for being registered as a Contractor under these rules unless -

Special

a) In the case of special class Contractors, the individual or firm:-

(i) has sound financial capacity to execute the works of the Department in that class; and

(ii) has a Government Engineering organization with at least one Degree holder (civil) and one Diploma Holder (Mechanical) holding firmly proof in support of having retained an approved class of consulting/Design Engineering

and Diploma holder civil and

(iii) Possess the following Plant and Equipment namely:-

Dozer or shovel	-1
Truck or Tipper	-2
Concrete Mixer	-4
Concrete Vibrator	-1
Compressor	-1
Diagonal Generator with welding plant	-1
Concrete compression Testing machine	-1
Theodolite	-1
Surveying Level	-1, and

Cost Index :-

(iv) should have successfully and satisfactorily completed as a contractor at least four works of an aggregate value not less than Rs. 100.00 lacs and should have worked as Class A contractor for at least five years; and

(v) In case of technically qualified individuals or firms, the field experience in respect of construction of works by an individual or any one of the partners of the firm required shall be ten years for a degree holder in Civil Engineering and 25 years for a Diploma Holder in Civil Engineering.

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(b) In the case of Class 'A' contractors, the firm or individual:-

(i) has sound financial capacity to execute the works of the Department in that class; and

(ii) Shall be required to employ technical staff at the time of award of works on the following basis,

(a) For works costing Rupees twenty lacs to fifty lacs,

At least one Degree holder (civil) and one Diploma holder (civil) or (Mechanical)

4. Eligibility B- No person shall be eligible for being registered as a Contractor under these rules unless he

Special

(a) in the case of special class Contractors, the individual or firm:-

(i) has sound financial capacity to execute the works of the Department in that class; and

(ii) has a Government Engineering organization with at least one Degree holder (civil) and one Diploma holder (Mechanical) holding certificates in support of having retained an approved firm of consulting/Design Engineering

(iii) Possess the following Plant and Equipment namely:-

- Dozer or shovel -1
- Truck or Tipper -2
- Concrete Mixer -2
- Concrete Vibrator -1
- Compressor -1
- Diesel Generator with welding plant -1
- Concrete compression Testing machine -1
- Theodolite -1
- Surveying Level -1, and

Cost Index :-

(iv) should have successfully and satisfactorily completed as a contractor at least four works of an aggregate value not less than Rs. 100.00 lacs and should have worked as Class A contractor for at least five years; and

(v) in case of technically qualified individuals or firms, the field experience in respect of construction of works by an individual or any one of the partners of the firm required shall be ten years for a degree holder in Civil Engineering and 25 years for a Diploma holder in Civil Engineering.

Part 1

(b) in the case of Class 'A' contractors, the firm or individual:-

(i) has sound financial capacity to execute the works of the Department in that class; and

(ii) Shall be required to employ technical staff at the time of award of works on the following basis,

(a) For works costing Rupees twenty lacs to fifty lacs,

At least one Degree holder (civil) and one Diploma holder (civil) or (Mechanical)

(b) For works consisting between Rupees ten lakh to Rupees twenty lacs.

At least one Diploma Holder (civil).

- (iii) Possess the following plant and equipment namely:-
- Truck or tipper -1
 - Concrete Mixer -2
 - Concrete Vibrator -2
 - Compressor -1
 - Diesel Generating set with Welding plant -1
 - concrete compression Testing Machine -1
 - Surveying level -1 ; and

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(iv)

Should have successfully and satisfactorily completed as a class 'B' contractor at least three works of an aggregate value of not less than Rs. 20.00 lacs and should have worked as a Class 'B' Contractor for 3 years;

(v)

In case of technically qualified individual or firms the field requirement in respect of construction of civil works by an individual/any one of the partners of the firm required shall be 7 years for a Degree holder in civil Engineering and 15 years for a Diploma Holder in civil Engineering

(c) In the case of class 'B' Contractors or the firm or individual :-

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- (1) For sound financial capacity to execute the works of Department in that class; and
- (ii) shall be required to employ at least one Diploma Holder (Civil) at Rs. 5.00 lacs, and works costing over
- (iii) Possess the following Plant and equipment namely:-
 - Truck or Tipper -1
 - Concrete Mixer -1
 - Concrete Vibrator -2 , and

and possess

(iv) Should have successfully and satisfactorily completed as a class 'C' contractor at least three works of an aggregate value of not less than Rupees ten lacs and should have worked as a Class 'C' contractor for three years; and

(v)

In case of technically qualified individual or firms, the field requirement in respect of construction of Civil works by an individual or any one of the partners of the firm required shall be three years for a Degree Holder in Civil Engineering and then years for a Diploma Holder in Civil Engineering.

(d) In the case of Class 'C' Contractor, the individual or firm :-

- (i) has sound financial capacity to execute the works of the Department in that class; and
- (ii) possesses the following plant and equipment namely:-

Concrete Mixer
Concrete Vibrator

(iii) should have successfully and satisfactorily completed as a contractor at least three works of an aggregate value of not less than Rupees two lacs and should have worked as Class 'C' Contractor for two years;

Provided that no field experience shall be required for enlistment in this class for Degree and Diploma holder in Civil Engineering;

(e) In the case of class 'D' contractors, the individual or firm;

(i) has sound financial capacity to execute the works of the Department in that class; and

(ii) should have worked at least with any registered 'D' class contractor for a period of one year and acquainted himself or themselves sufficiently with the elementary knowledge required for execution of civil works; the certificate in this respect should among other things indicate the name of work where the applicant has worked.

(iii) Provided that no field experience shall be required for enlistment in this class for Degree and Diploma holder in Civil Engineering.

Note : The service period of a Degree or Diploma holder in Civil Engineering in Government or semi-

Government organisation shall be considered as a field experience for the eligibility;

Explanation :- For purpose of this rule an individual or firm shall be considered to have sound financial capacity if he or it possesses property and Bank balances not below the extent shown against each written certificate of an Officer not below the rank of Assistant Commissioner (Revenue) or a scheduled Bank certifying minimum cash balances during past three months;

Class (i)	Movable (Liquid)	Immovable (Assets)
Class Special	Rupees Five Lacs	Rupees fifteen Lacs
Class (A)	Rupees Three Lacs	Rupees seven Lacs
Class (B)	One lac and fifty thousand	Rupees two lacs and fifty thousand

Class (D)	Rupees ten thousand	Rupees fifty thousand

Further the contractors otherwise eligible to various classes under these rules and possessing degree or diploma in Civil Engineering shall be entitled to fifty percent concession in respect of financial requirement both under Movable and Immovable assets as defined above.

(5) Application for Registration (1) An application for registration by a person or firm intending to carry on business as a contractor of a particular class shall be submitted to the Head of the Department in form I, alongwith following certificates/affidavits, namely:-

- (i) Solvency certificate from a scheduled Bank (for all classes except class D);
- (ii) Income tax clearance certificate pertaining to preceding assessment year (for all classes except class -D).
- (iii) Legal bond to the effect that Machinery and immovable property declared by him/them is free from all encumbrances except the mortgage of the lending Bank/Public sector Financial Institution and will not be transferred or disposed off by him/them without specific authorisation of the Registering Authority (for all classes).
- (iv) Legal bond authorising the department to recover any money due from him/them on any account by sale, auction or his/their immovable property (for all classes).
- (v) Character certificate to be issued by an Officer being not below the rank of Superintendent of Police of the District concerned after due verification from CID.
- (vi) Certificate from Chief Engineers of different Wiggs or District Superintending Engineers that the applicant (s) has not/have not backed out from any contract and the work and conduct in relation to works of any of the Department have been satisfactorily executed.
- (vii) an affidavit (for all classes) to the effect --
 - (a) that the applicant has not been enlisted earlier or refused enlistment or black-listed;
 - (b) that the applicant is not already in service in any Government department, Corporation or undertaking or a member of either House of the parliament or legislature, District Development Board or a student of any educational institute or in receipt of any stipend from the Government.
 - (c) that the applicant (s) if a retired employee(s) of Government /Corporation or undertaking is not disallowed under service conduct Rules of the Government/Corporation/undertaking from where he has retired.

(a) that the applicant has not been declared insolvent by a court of competent jurisdiction;

(b) that the applicant has not been convicted of an offence under chapters VII and VIII of Public Order Code 1950, or under the Licensing and Profiteering (Control) Ordinance (Cap. 219):

(c) that the applicant (a) has not / have not been in breach of any contract in India / West Bengal;

(2) On receipt of application accompanied by certificates and affidavits indicating to the satisfaction of the authorized representative of the firm seeking registration may be called upon for personal attendance before the Head of the Department.

(3) The Head of Department in case application has been made shall thereupon scrutinize the application and unless the applicant is found ineligible, he shall enter the contents of the application in a register maintained by him for the purpose and inform the applicant accordingly for payment of registration fee, prescribed hereunder:-

(i) Class Special	A. Twenty thousand	
(ii) Class A	B. Ten thousand	10,000/-
(iii) Class B	C. Five thousand	5000/-
(iv) Class C	D. Two thousand five hundred	2500/-
(v) Class D	E. One thousand	1000/-

(4) The applicant may be registered even for a Class lower than applied for.

Note: A Central register of contractors as enlisted shall be maintained by the Public Works Department as per format specified in Form No. IV. Head of Department shall furnish information in the prescribed format to the department for purpose of maintaining a consolidated record of contractors.

(5) Grounds of refusal of registration Notwithstanding anything contained in rule 4, the Head of Department may refuse registration or renewal of registration of applicant/firm under those rules on any of the following grounds, namely:

(a) If he has been declared as insolvent by a court of competent jurisdiction in India or West Bengal.

if he is convicted for an offence punishable under chapters XVII and XVIII of the Rajbir Pahal code Samvat 1909; or xxx under the Hoarding and profiteering Ordinance, Samvat, 2000; or

- (b) If the Head of the Department is of the opinion that the contractor has habitually booked out from the contract tendered by him in the Public Works Department;
- (c) If the Head of the Department is of the opinion that the work and conduct of the applicant has not been satisfactory in relation to the work of the Public Works Department executed by him in the past.

7. Notice for refusal. - If the Head of Department proposes to refuse registration of an applicant on any ground mentioned above, he shall serve upon the applicant a notice indicating the ground on which the registration is proposed to be refused, and the applicant may either himself or through his authorised agent submit his objections, if any, regarding order of the refusal.

8. Order of refusal. - If the Head of Department is of the opinion that the objections filed by the applicant are not satisfactory, he shall pass orders refusing the registration and communicate the orders to the concerned.

9. Issue of certificate. - (1) The Head of Department or the person to whom application has been made shall upon scrutinising the application, deposition of prescribed fee and unless the applicant is ineligible under rule 4 or the registration or renewal thereof is refused under rule 5 or 6 and ensuring that the contents of the application have been recorded in a register maintained by the department for the purpose, issue a certificate of registration of the class in Form II.

(2) Once the certificate of registration has been issued, the contractor shall be eligible to purchase tender form against fee to be prescribed by the tender inviting authority depending upon the cost of tender document viz-a viz cost of work and, thereafter cast his tender in the manner so stipulated.

10. Validity of Certificate. - (1) The certificate of registration under these rules shall be valid for one consecutive financial year (including the year during which the certificate of registration is issued) and shall be renewable after every financial year, subject to the provisions of these rules. The certificate shall be got renewed preferably before the end of financial year in which the validity expires or latest before the end of the April following that financial year. Fresh affidavits/certificates shall be required to be furnished in respect of the under-mentioned requirements:

I/ Income Tax clearance certificate pertaining to preceding year;

II/ An affidavit to the effect;

(a) that the applicant has not been black-listed;

- (b) that the applicant is not already, in service in any Government Department, Corporation or undertaking or a member of either House of the Parliament or the State Legislature, District Development Board or a student of any educational institution or ~~in receipt~~ receipt of any stipend from the Government.
- (c) that the applicant has not been declared insolvent by any court of competent jurisdiction.

Besides the above affidavit, the following certificates shall be produced from the concerned superintending Engineers or Executive Engineers under whose supervision the works have been executed during the period by the contractor, seeking renewal of registration;

- (a) Character certificate to be issued by an Officer not less than the rank of Superintendent of Police of concerned District after verification from CID.
- (b) a certificate to be issued by an Officer not less than the rank of Superintending Engineer that the applicant has not / have not backed out from the contract in Public works department.
- (c) a certificate to be issued by an Officer not below the rank of Superintending Engineer that the applicant's work and conduct remained satisfactory in relation to work of Public works Department and the quality of work executed by the contractor remained good.
- (d) a certificate to be issued by an Officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer that the applicant has not been a defaulter in making payment to the Labour engaged by him and there have not been or is any labour claim/award pending against him in a labour court on account of works allotted.

(2) An application for renewal of registration shall be made to the Head of the Department in Form III and shall be accompanied by the following fees:

1/ Special Class	→	Rupees four thousand
II/ Class A	→	Rupees two thousand and five hundred
III/ Class B	→	Rupees one thousand two hundred and fifty.
IV/ Class C	→	Rupees six hundred and fifty
V/ Class D	→	Rupees two hundred and fifty.

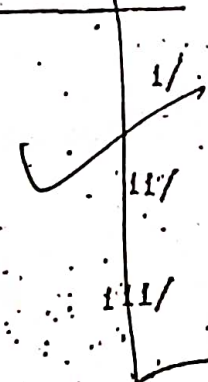
Clause Renew

(3) In case any contractor fails to renew the registration as specified above, the registration can be renewed after charging a penalty equal to the renewal fee. However, if a contractor fails to renew his registration for two consecutive days terms. It will automatically cease to be operative and he shall have to apply for a fresh registration, if he is desirous of continuing his business.

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11. Suspension or black listing - 1) If at any time, after a person is registered as contractor, the Head of Department is satisfied that such contractor has incurred any of the dis-qualifications in these rules, he shall serve a notice upon the contractor, indicating the ground on which it is proposed to suspend or blacklist or remove his name from the register, to show cause why such order should not be issued.
(2) If the Head of Department is of the opinion that the explanation tendered by the contractor is not satisfactory he shall pass an order of suspension or black-listing or removal of the name of the contractor from the register and such order shall be communicated to the contractor.

Explanation:



- Norms for suspension or black-listing or removal shall be as under :
- i/ One time backing out from the contract shall invoke suspension of registration for one year.
- ii/ For 2nd time backing out from the contract the suspension of registration for two years shall be invoked.
- iii/ third time backing out from the contract shall cause black-listing for five years

provided that no such order of suspension or black-listing or removal shall prevent the contractor from executing and completing the works or effect his rights and obligations in respect of any contract sanctioned to him that department or any other department while the registration was in force.

12. All orders passed by Head of Department under rule 11 shall be communicated to the Department and also be got published in the Government Gazettes.

13. All India Contractors

Nothing in these rules shall apply to such contractors from outside the State who offer to execute the works in the State in response to all India or the Global tenders.



1A. Repeal and Saving.

1). The Jammu and Kashmir Registration of Contractors Rules, 1969, are hereby repealed.

(2). Notwithstanding such repeal, anything duly done or any action taken in exercise of any powers conferred by or under the said rules shall be deemed to have been done or taken in exercise of the powers conferred by or under these rules.

2. "The words 'Head of Department' wherever occurring in the said Rules shall be substituted by the words 'Competent Authority'."



The existing contractors are required to get themselves enrolled on the said web portal. The competent authorities of the department as per SRO 277 of 2010 dated 26-07-2010 are enabled to verify, validate and issue/renew/upgrade the registration cards of the contractors on the said portal.

The contractors already registered on the web portal are required to ensure that all the credentials uploaded on their profile are correct and updated. Besides the request for renewal or upgradation of their registration has to be done through online mode only.

Henceforth no offline contractor card will be issued.

Srinagar, the 28th May, 2022**

S.O. 261 .- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 10 read with section 9 of the Jammu and Kashmir Registration of Contractors Act, 1956, the Government hereby makes the following amendment in the Jammu and Kashmir Registration of Contractor Rules, 1991; namely: -

- (i) In rule 9, after sub-rule(1), the following proviso shall be added:-
"Provided that 68 Hot Mix Plant holders registered as 'A' class contractors to hold such contractors license registered upto 31.03.2022 shall be deemed to have been issued under these rules as one time exception."
- (ii) In rule 10, sub rule (1), for the words "shall be renewable after every financial year" the words "shall be renewable after every three financial years" shall be substituted.
- (iii) In rule 10, in clause ii(a) of sub-rule(1), for the words "Character Certificate" the words "written model affidavit, as may be prescribed, to be accepted provisionally till character certificate is issued or character certificate" shall be substituted.
- (iv) In rule 10, sub-rule(2) shall be substituted as under:-

"(2) An application for renewal of registration shall be made to the head of the Department in Form III and shall be accompanied by the following fees:

i)	Special Class	Rs 12,000/-
ii)	Class A	Rs 7500/-
iii)	Class B	Rs 3750/-
iv)	Class C	Rs 1950/-
v)	Class D	Rs 750/-

Provided that the Hot Mix Plants which have been exempted under proviso to sub-rule (1) of rule 9 shall have to fulfil all the codal formalities within a period of six months from the date of issuance of this notification.”

- (v) In rule 10, after sub-rule (2) the following shall be added as sub-rule(2a):-

“(2a) the time period for renewal of contractor licence shall be extended upto a period of 31.05.2022 for financial year 2022-2023 in online mode only.

Provided that all Licenses shall henceforth through online mode only.”


